Caritas Humanitarian Aid & Relief Initiatives (Singapore) Ltd is the umbrella body for overseas humanitarian aid and disaster relief efforts of the Archdiocese of Singapore.

Our Purpose: As one Body in Christ, to inspire, unite and enable the Catholic Community in Singapore, to love and serve our neighbours in the region through humanitarian aid and disaster response.

Position: Executive – Volunteer & Outreach + Disaster Response & Missions

We seek to hire an Executive responsible for supporting our Volunteer & Outreach (V&O) as well as Disaster Relief & Missions (DR&M) activities within CHARIS. This role will be reporting to the Executive Director of CHARIS, and working closely with the Chairpersons of the respective committees that he/she supports.

Key Responsibilities:

- 1. Supporting the CHARIS Volunteer & Outreach Committee in engaging our pool of volunteers and network of parishes, CHARIS Member Organisations (MOs) and partners:
 - a) Engaging new and existing volunteers with volunteering opportunities both within CHARIS and in support of our MOs.
 - b) Serve as point of contact for Parishes in promoting CHARIS' events and activities, as well as any support needed by them.
 - c) Supporting our Member Organisations in promoting their events and activities, leveraging on CHARIS' Digital Engagement Platform.
 - d) Engaging Catholic schools to organise talks or activities to share and plant the seed for missionary discipleship at an early age.
 - e) Help in organizing events and activities to inspire, unite and enable volunteers, such as CHARIS Overseas Humanitarian Foundation Course, and other hard and soft skills workshops.
- 2. Supporting the CHARIS Disaster Response & Missions Committee in defining and executing our desired goals and activities, including:
 - Function as the key point of contact for CHARIS within Caritas Asia's Strengthening Humanitarian Partnerships & Exchanges (SHAPE) programme, to define a holistic framework and collaboration model in addressing the needs of disaster response activities across the region.
 - b) Organising Disaster Response specific training programmes for CHARIS Member Organisations and Volunteers.



- c) Defining a set of logistics support SOP and protocols, including liaising with suppliers, transport providers, overseas partners and sister organisations, local and foreign authorities, etc.
- d) Planning, coordination and execution of CHARIS mission trips, in collaboration with either CHARIS grants beneficiaries, Caritas Asia MOs or CHARIS MOs.
- 3. Each secretariat in CHARIS is assigned to support one or more CHARIS Committees that oversee various programmes and functions of CHARIS:
 - a) Assist the respective Committee Chairman in the planning and execution of regular and adhoc meetings, including logistics support and minuting.
 - b) Reviewing, updating and implementing policies and procedures related to areas within above roles and responsibilities where necessary.
- 4. Other general responsibilities:
 - a) As part of the CHARIS Secretariat team, the candidate may also be assigned other tasks as may be required in support of the operations of CHARIS.
 - b) As part of teamwork, the candidate is also expected to help in the execution of all events and activities across functions and committees where necessary.
 - c) As a Catholic organisation and as part of the broader Archdiocese in Singapore, the candidate is expected to participate in spiritual and formation activities in the course of our work.

- Experience in planning events & activities.
- Experience in overseas missions will be an added advantage.
